Danish Alliance for Responsible Coffee

Launched in 2022, 35 participating members including companies, civil society and sector organisations, share the **vision** that behind every cup of coffee consumed in Denmark lie committed partnerships to regenerate nature, improve livelihoods, and build climate change resilience to ensure a sustainable future for this essential product.



Members commit to contribute to the Alliance's 4 missions: 1) **Regeneration and climate action**, 2) **Living income and better livelihoods**, 3) **Accountability in the value chain**, and 4) **Communication**.

Members define their commitment in a **public action plan**, and report their progress through an annual survey. Status reports are published yearly. The alliance also works to increase **knowledge among buyers and consumers**, for example in the **guide for public procurement** published in 2025.

STATUS REPORT 2024

Danish Alliance for Responsible Coffee

HIGHLIGHTS

Company members represent the majority (60% of 2024 import volume) of coffee consumed in Denmark.

Over 40% of the reported Alliance volume supported by members' programs, include working on regenerative production and improving farmer incomes.

There is an increased import of 'agroforestry coffee', with half of reporting members disclosing % imported coffee.

Steady increase of organic and certified coffee since 2022, with 14% combined volume

Six reporting members in 2024 have indicated to have calculated **Scope 3 emissions** for 100% of their imported coffee, and 55% of the combined volume of the ten reporting members is traceable to farm level.
